What is return assistance?

The return assistance supports you in returning to your country of origin. It facilitates your new start and improves the chances of a successful reintegration.

What is return counselling?

The return counselling informs you non-binding and confidentially on the return assistance and has no influence on still

pending proceedings. The return counselling supports you in the preparation and organisation of your return.

Who can receive return assistance?

The return assistance is open to all asylum seekers who want to return voluntarily to their countries of origin. Recognized refugees can also receive return assistance.

When and how?

You can apply for return assistance both during and after the completion of the asylum proceedings.
